SCHOOL RULES

DRESS

1. The rules regarding items of school uniform are as follows:—

Blazers: Forms I-V, single-breasted; VIth Forms, single or double breasted. All blazers must bear the school badge on the pocket.

Coats: Forms I-V, navy blue, overcoat or raincoat. VIth Form boys may wear navy blue, grey or fawn raincoats.

Plastic or nylon mackintoshes are permitted for protection against showers.

Shoes: Black.

Shirts: Plain grey or white.

Trousers: Plain grey flannel, worsted or terylene.

Pullovers: Plain grey, navy-blue or black with vee-neck—school colours at neck are allowed.

Socks: Plain grey.

Scarves: School scarves, cloth or knitted.

Boys who cycle may wear cycling capes; those with permission to ride motorcycles may wear suitable protective clothing and crash helmets are obligatory.

2. This uniform must be worn on the journey to and from School, and at all School representative functions, whether these are held on the School premises or not.

3. If any headdress is worn it must be the School cap and nothing else, with the exception that Prefects may wear boaters in the Summer Term.

4. School caps, ties, blazers and other recognised School clothing may be obtained from

Messrs. C. Hewitt & Son of Church Street, Croydon.

5. The wearing of rings is not permitted.

PUNCTUALITY

1. Boys must be in their form rooms before 8.50 a.m. and in the appropriate room for the sixth period before 2.30 p.m.

2. Any boy who is late will be dealt with by his Form Master in the first place, but persistent offenders will be reported to the Deputy Head Master.

CLASSROOMS

ensure that they are returned in good condition.

2. All text books must bear the name and form of the boy to whom they have been loaned and must be covered in brown paper or other suitable protective material.

PROPERTY

1. Defacement of, or wilful damage to, any property, whether public or private, is forbidden. Accidental damage must be reported immediately.

2. All private property must be clearly marked with the owner's name.

3. Money, watches, etc., must not be left in changing rooms but should be handed to the master in charge of the form in the Gymnasium or at the Playing Field.

GENERAL

1. There are special regulations which apply to the use of the Dining Hall, Gymnasia, Laboratories, Library, Playing Fields, Shooting Range, etc. These regulations are either posted on the appropriate notice boards or notified at the proper time, and must be strictly observed.

2. All dangerous weapons or substances (e.g., water-pistols, catapults, fireworks) are forbidden on the school premises.

3. Any boys whose behaviour, manners or appearance are such as to bring discredit to the School at any time or place will be regarded as having broken a School rule.

OTHER INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

The Headmaster may be seen by parents and guardians at any time by appointment.
